ARRANGE TO ATTEND.

The Riddell Lectures—Opening Number Sunday Evening—Arrangements for Intellectual Treat.

Mr. Newton N. Riddell, the well-known lecturer on brain building and soul growth, has been secured by the Y. M. C. A. to give a series of lectures under their auspices, beginning Sunday evening, January 5. The subject of the opening address will be "Science and Religion." This lecture will be followed by a series on consecutive evenings, beginning during the week at 7:45.

Realization of man's highest ideals is the goal of the Riddell lectures. No metaphysical vagaries, traditional dogmas, nor personal theories, but demonstrable facts and laws whereby man may realize health, harmony, happiness, heaven, here and now. They have been given at nearly all of the leading Chautauques, as well as in our larger cities. No admission fee will be charged for the series, a silver offering being taken each night to defray expenses. The hour of the lecture is 8 o'clock each night, except Sunday, when it will be 7:30. A question box will be conducted at 7:45 each night.

The opening lecture will be held in the First Methodist church, the rest of the series in the First Baptist church.

"Are You Crazy?"

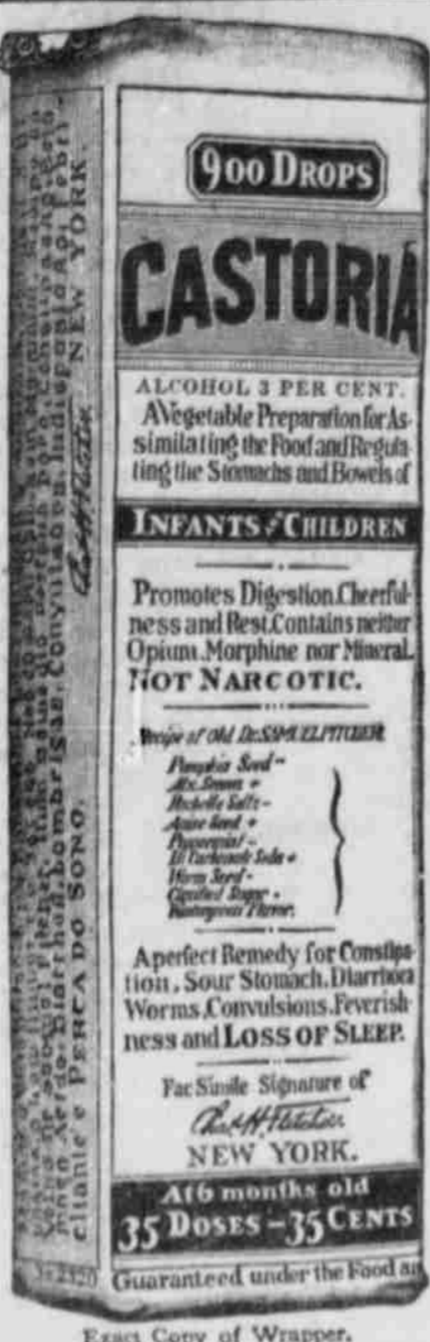

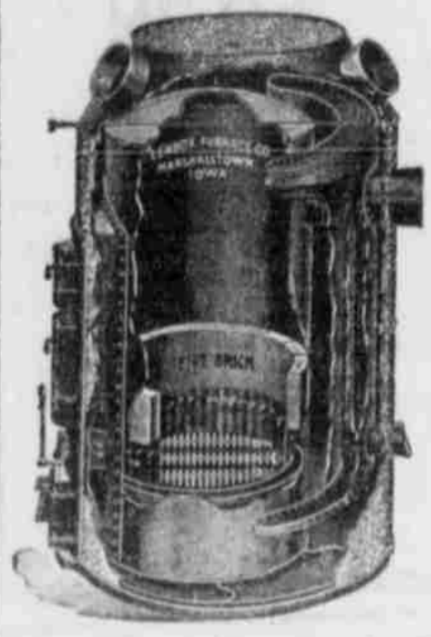
