## SCHOOL GARDENS IN STATE OF KENTUCKY

One of the most interesting records of progress in the cultivation of school gardens is that of the schools of Louisville, Ky. The first steps in the movement, which was promoted by the Outdoor Art League of the Kentucky city, were taken by the normal school eight years ago. The Outdoor Art League is affiliated with the American Civic Association.

In her recent report read before the Commercial club, which gave financial aid to the school gardens, Miss Emilie Yunker, chairman of the school garden committee, presented facts and comment which are of value to those in other cities interested in the work.

Here follows an extract of Miss Yunker's report:  
"Nine-tenths of the successful business men have been reared on the farm. There they have learned quick observation and quick decision, which are of great value throughout their lives. What form of study does as much for the city child as the garden?"

"With the hearty co-operation of Professor E. H. Mark, superintendent of schools, and the financial support of the school board and the Commercial club, many schoolyards were beautified last year with flowering shrubs, hedges, vines and other plants. To stimulate the work seeds were offered at a penny a packet.

"In making preparation for planting the children were told to remove all rubbish, beautify their own as well as the schoolyards. They were urged not to violate the A B C of landscape gardening and advised to grow some of the reliable hardy plants. School gardens are not made in one year. In order to show what can be done with persistence, patience and industry, I will tell briefly the history of the normal school garden.

"Like many others, the entire yard was paved, with the exception of a small grass plot in front. After having indoor laboratory work with seeds and plants grown in the window garden, there was a demand for more space. A strip of ground near the house was converted into a flower border. Finding the garden rather small, a back yard was accepted, where vegetables and flowers were grown. In the fall a basketful of popcorn was gathered and popped one frosty afternoon over a grate fire, much to the delight of the young gardeners.

"Civic pride has been aroused. Our garden is having its influence on the neighborhood. A few years ago a garden in the heart of the city was like flying in the face of Providence. So far, not a flower has been missed. Ofttimes a passerby will stop to ask the name of a flower. Now and then a plant will be given to the inquirer, with home instruction as to its cultivation.

"In 1904 the principal succeeded in having bricks taken up in the back yard and a vegetable garden, 17 by 24 feet, was planted. Two years later two feet of bricks the entire length of the yard were removed and vines and flowers planted. This year the boys of the fourth grade built a fence separating the vegetable garden from the playground. We had a creditable exhibit of vegetables and school work pertaining to the garden.

"Who can measure the good thus done? All the surplus energy of the child is conducted into channels of industry. His mind is filled with high ideals. Besides the foundation of good citizenship is being laid.

"Where gardens have been conducted long enough to make practical tests it has been found that 30 per cent of the children having garden work are more rapid in physical development than those not having gardens."—American Civic Association.

The Oregonian is roaring so much about the supreme court deciding everything on technicalities. It forgets that many a poor editor who has been cinched like Putman of Medford, for criminal libel, has been let off in the supreme court on a technicality. A court of last review is compelled to be technical. It is a court of appellate jurisdiction and all appeals are reviewed upon points of law and alleged errors of rulings of the trial judge on admission of testimony or giving the law unto the jury. We would rather have a court that is technical than be tried by the popular passions and mob spirit that is sometimes engendered by newspapers to the extent that it sways juries. Witness the conviction by popular prejudice and political bias as engendered in the Heney trials. Have they promoted the cause of justice or made a trace of convictions. Nearly all so far have not stood the test of the higher courts. Sifted convictions procured by manufactured public sentiment are vicious.

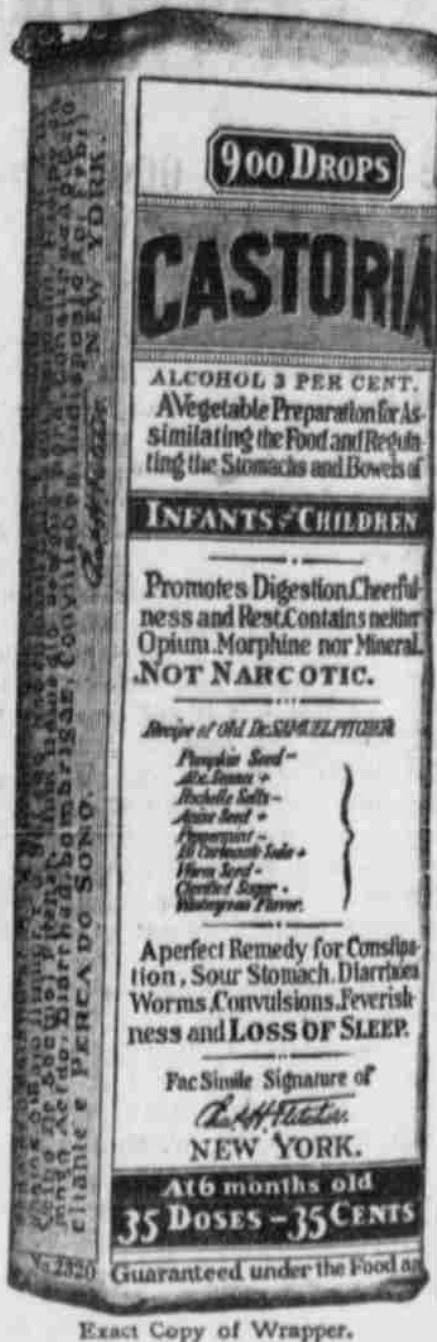

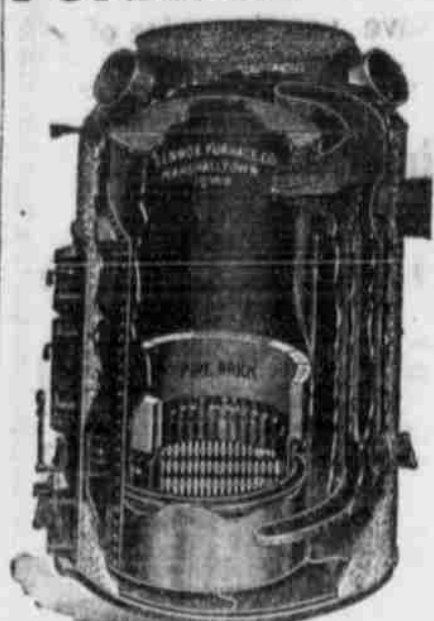
