WILL RUN THE WEEK

"Parsifal" patrons should bear in mind the unusual hour of commencement, the performance will begin promptly at 7:45, and the management requests that every one be seated by that time, as none can be shown to their seats during the action of the play.

Charles B. Hanford.
Mr. Charles B. Hanford who appears here soon in "Antony and Cleopatra," needs no introduction to Salem people for this will be his seventh appearance here in Shakespearean character, and if the great playwright holds out Mr. Hanford will probably break the record and present the entire list of Shakespeare's creation. In the season of 1901-2 he made his first appearance in "The Taming of the Shrew." The next season he presented "Much Ado About Nothing." In 1903-04 he gave "Richard III." In 1904-05, "The Merchant of Venice." Last season he appeared in "Julius Caesar," and this year he presents "Antony and Cleopatra." This season he has 29 people with him, a splendid chorus, and the scenic presentation is said to be one of the most perfect ever put on the stage. Mr. Hanford is a favorite with Salem people and that a full house will greet him is assured.
