WILL MAKE JAPAN SHOW HER HAND.

Washington, Feb. 21.—The state department on advice of the President is expected within a short time to address a circular note to the powers, calling attention to Japan's anti-open door attitude in Manchuria, the open-door being the American policy.

If conditions make it necessary, Japan will be asked to show her hand in Manchuria, where great American, British and other international interests are involved.

WEST POINT CUR AIRS HIS OPINION.

(United Press Leased Wire.)
New York, Feb. 21.—Prefacing his article with stories of two imaginary wars in which America is badly beaten up by Germany in her Eastern and Japan in her western states Lieutenant Hugh Johnson, United States army, writing in the March issue of Everybody's Magazine, holds the United States military system up to scorn.

He refers to the navy as "respectable," but says its "fighting chance is impossible of determination."

"We have no army, but what is worse," he says, "we have no system of defense. In resources we are rich; in actual power we are as poor as Job. Germany can mobilize 1,000,000 in a month, France as many, Japan 800,000—we, 1,000,000 in two years."

MAY ESTABLISH TARGET RANGE

(United Press Leased Wire.)
Washington, Feb. 21.—Citizens of Monterey, Cal., hope that their pretty city will soon be the scene of a small arms target range of the navy department. Adjutant-General Lauck has brought up the question of securing a suitable range for rifle practice by the militia in conjunction with the navy. The people of Monterey have submitted, through Representative Needham, a plat of the site which they propose the navy shall select, and Commander Sims, inspector of the naval practice, has said that he will recommend an inspection of the ground by some officer of the battleship Nebraska, although the fact that a railroad runs through the tract may be against it.

The navy needs a place where 2000 men at a time can disembark and shoot at targets, and one requirement of the range is that it shall not be too far from a good anchorage.

PHILADELPHIA ANARCHISTS

(United Press Leased Wire.)
Philadelphia, Pa., Feb. 21.—Twenty Italians and Poles are today nursing painful injuries as the result of a riot following a demonstration on the part of 1000 foreigners, who, marching in a body, sought to compel Mayor Reyburn to give them work. On their way to the city hall they flaunted red flags and jerked from the seats of wagon drivers who attempted to cross the street in front of them. In many instances some of these victims were badly beaten by the foreigners. Even when the police interfered with the plans of the anarchists they showed resistance. In the riot that followed many of the unemployed were knocked down, and 14 were arrested.

On last Friday night Varvaris was held up and robbed, but not assaulted. As the highwayman left the place he made this remark: "If I see an account of this having been reported to the police I shall come back and kill you."
