Friends tried to patch up the trouble between them on more than one occasion during the day, but the bitter feeling increased hourly.

When the two men again last night the quarrel was resumed. In a fit of desperation Hyde drew a revolver and fired point blank at his opponent. The first bullet hit Kemp and he fell mortally wounded. He died within a few seconds. The excit ment occasioned by the tragedy is intense today. Threats against the life of Hyde are freely gnade. Hyde surrendered, and is being closely guarded in his coil.
