Preparing Street Monuments.

City Attorney Keyes has prepared an ordinance for submission to the council next Monday night providing for monuments on all the principal streets of the city to show the exact line of these thoroughfares. These monuments are to be made of two pieces of solid granite 34 inches in height and 5 inches thick, and will be placed at corners according to the report of Surveyor T. C. Tillman, which is affixed to the bill. On streets not having the monument, iron or wooden stakes will be used.
