"I have not the slightest doubt concerning the efficiency of our fighting vessels," he said. "In war it would demonstrate that here is no better fighting unit in the world."  
Mr. Morton said that little attention should be given criticisms directed against the fleet.

### Coreans Wanted Papers.

It developed today that the assassins sought more than the life of Stevens when they shot him down. The possession of certain important papers Stevens was supposed to have had with him is now said to have been as great a motive as the desire for revenge. When Stevens fell in front of the ferry building, after Chang had fired two bullets into him, an attempt was made by a companion of the assassin during the excitement following the shooting, to secure possession of Stevens' portmanteau, but Japanese Consul Koike, who was with Stevens, frustrated this part of the plot.

The papers, which the Coreans believe to be detrimental to the interests of their country, are supposed by them to be a statement from the Corean council of state, and which is to be presented by Japanese Takahira, in an informal and unofficial way, to President Roosevelt, his advisors and the leaders in congress. The papers are deemed by the Corean patriots in this city and at Seoul to misrepresent the facts concerning Japan's stewardship of Korea. They also believe that the documents were forced from the Corean council, and, to prevent it reaching Washington, the attack on Stevens was planned

### STRIKE OF GERMAN REPORTERS

(United Press Leased Wire.)  
Berlin, March 24.—In response to an appeal from the reichstag, the striking newspaper reporters who unceremoniously withdrew from the assembly last week because an assemblyman denounced them, today informed Prime Minister Von Buelow that they would not return until the offending legislator makes an apology.

The reporters declare they are entitled to an apology, and they assure the prime minister that until one is forthcoming they will not resume their work of reporting the proceedings. he reichstag made the plea to the strikers on the ground that the public is entitled to the reports of the assembly.

### EMPEROR WILLIAM TO CORFU

(United Press Leased Wire.)  
Berlin, March 24.—Emperor William, accompanied by his wife, son, August, and many officials and royal couples, left today for his magnificent villa on the island of Corfu, where he will spend several days. The party went by way of Venice.

According to an official note, the emperor will be met at Venice by King Victor Emanuel, and that later he will visit Emperor Francis Joseph at Vienna. In official circles denial is made of the report that the Sultan of Turkey will send an embassy to Corfu to greet the German ruler. The emperor purchased the villa at Corfu last year. He considers it one of his best estates.

### SEATTLE BREAD TRUST COLLAPSES

(United Press Leased Wire.)  
Seattle, Wash., March 24.—The Seattle bread trust has collapsed. The association of bakers was formed last June, as a result of which practically every baker in the city agreed to furnish a standard 16-ounce loaf at the rate of 25 for a dollar to the grocers, which meant five cents straight to the consumer. Several bakers are selling as many as 25 at present, and some retailers are putting out seven loaves for 25 cents. Charges of short weight was the cause of the break.
