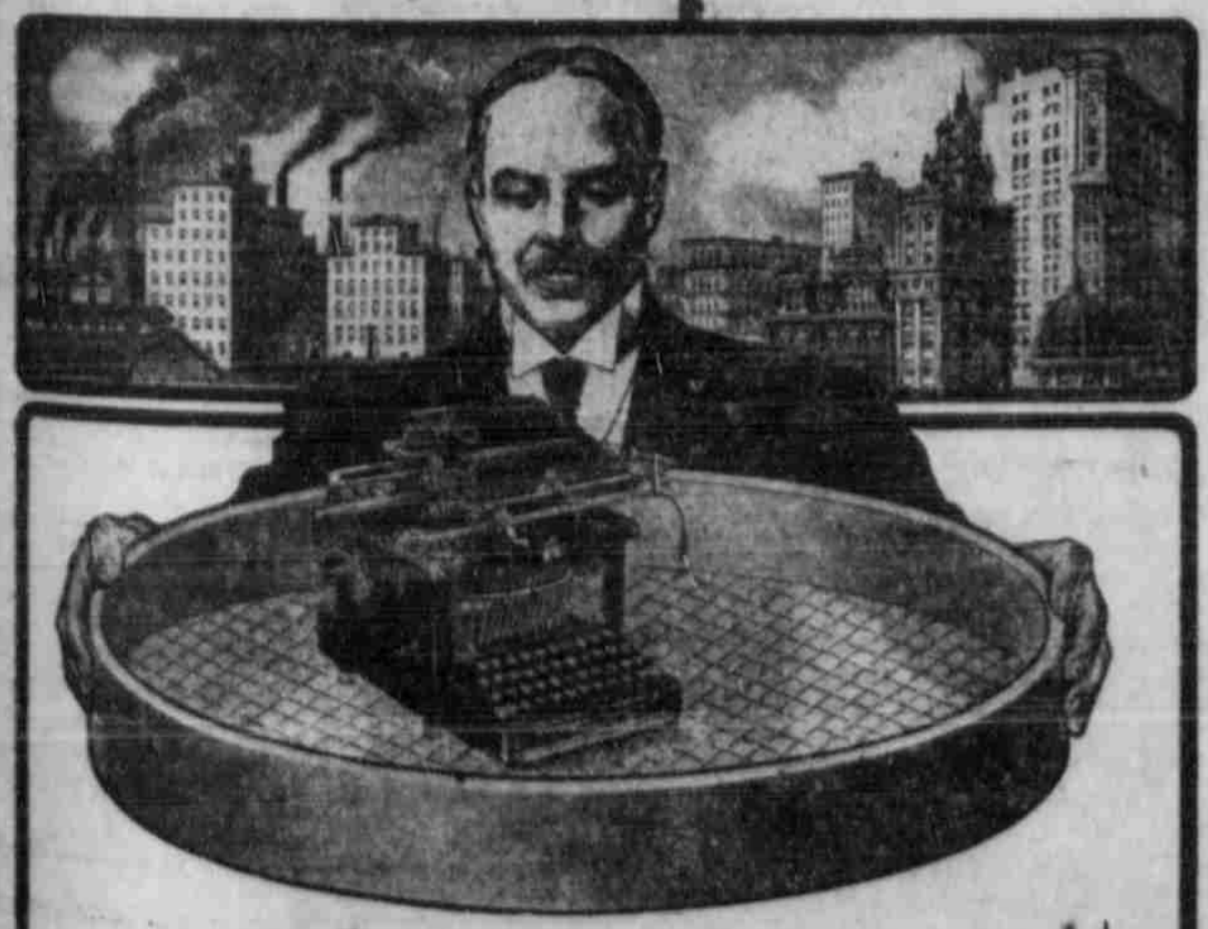

DEFEAT OF AN ENGLISH LABOR BILL

The Liberals and the Socialists came to a clash in the house of commons March 10th, and undoubtedly influenced to a certain extent by Lord Rosebery's speech against socialism, the Liberals threw overboard the unemployed workmen's bill of the Labor party. The majority majority it was 143.

The measure has become known as the "right to work" bill, because a vital clause makes it the duty of the local authorities to provide work for all unemployed persons, and failing this provision of work, the authorities shall provide maintenance for unemployed men and their families. The bill is frankly admitted to be socialistic in character.

As a result of a cabinet meeting the government, under the virile leadership of Herbert H. Asquith, chancellor of the exchequer, and acting premier, decided to risk a probable suit with the Socialist element. Asquith and John Burns, the labor leader in the house, both asked the house to reject the bill.

Mr. Burns declared that the passage of this bill would be most destructive to the social fabric. The government already was doing all that could reasonably be expected to improve the condition of labor. If it had made a mistake it was that it had gone too far and exalted tuc-tuc and corduroy above the frock coat and the top hat.

POSTMASTER WANTS HOUSES NUMBERED

House owners, who have failed to properly number their houses in accordance with the city ordinance, are likely soon to find themselves in trouble with the postoffice authorities unless they immediately make the necessary changes. A great deal of trouble is being experienced in the handling of mail both because the house numbers are missing on some residences and on others they have remained unchanged since the street were divided into north and south districts. Those who do not make the necessary changes may find the postoffice authorities invoking the law on them, and this might, in some cases, amount to very heavy damages as the city ordinance provides that owners who fail to place proper numbers on their houses will have to pay a fine of \$2.50 a day.

Postmaster Farrar stated to a Journal reporter this morning that it would materially assist the distribution of mail, and thereby enable letters to be delivered earlier, if residents would notify their correspondents of their proper addresses.
