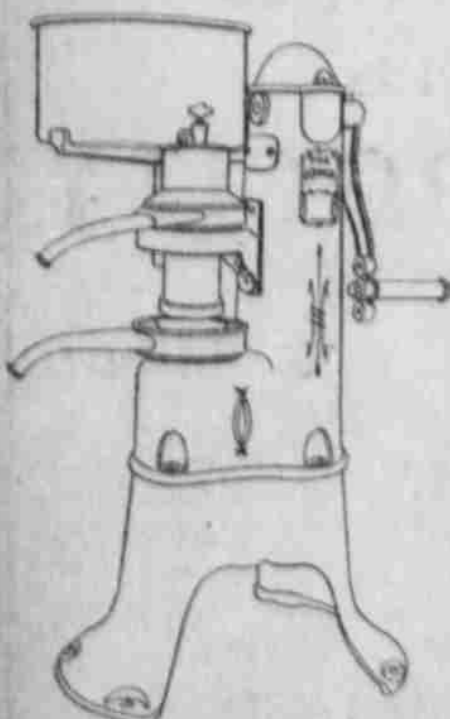

crowd, clubbing demonstrators and spectators alike.

The police were being roughly handled when a squad of mounted police, members of the tariff rioters, arrived on the scene, and swung their clubs over the heads of the rioters, charged into the mob and their horses.

In a moment Union Square was in the heart of the shopping office building district, was a scene of the wildest confusion. Caught in the rush for safety, frightened by the fighting and explosion fainting and a number said to have been trampled on. Fought to get out of the crowd and get at the police acting as sympathies ran.

Several days ago the agitation for permission to parade to hold a demonstration to show the people of New York the great number of men unemployed. The police believing that the demonstration to be more Socialistic than suspicious of the request to parade in Fifth avenue, the center of New York's wealth, and fearful of the influence of radicals on so great a number of men, refused the permit.
