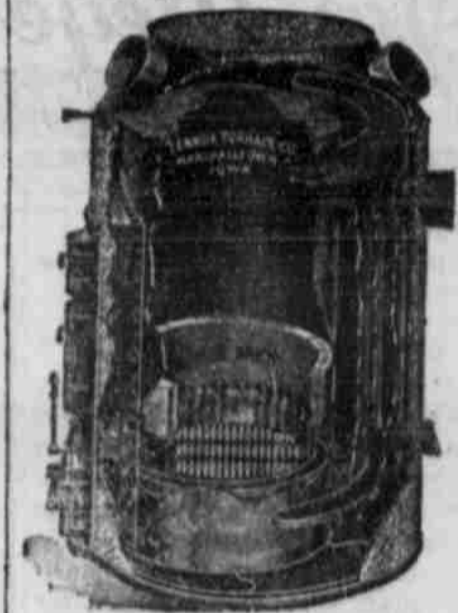

### PORTLAND HIGHBINDERS

(United Press Leased Wire.) Portland, Or., April 6.—Headed by Lim Ga Gee, a San Francisco leader in the Bow On tong, a delegation of 19 fighting men of the Bow Ons are skulking in Chinatown at Salem, Or., waiting for a favorable moment to slip into Portland to take part in the factional war of the Bow Ons that is raging here and which has already resulted in one murder, one attempted house burning and the mysterious disappearance of two other Chinese. Only the tireless work of the Chinatown squad, aided by a special detail of plain clothes men, had kept the feud smoldering during the last week, but the police confess that they expect an outbreak at any moment now. Lim Ga Gee and his squal of San

Francisco hatchet men are said to be coming here to take charge of the hostilities. The expense of the invasion from California is being paid by the Astoria branch of the tong, which raised \$1000 last week to defray the expense of the gun men in order to work off certain grievances they have against the Portland Bow Ons growing out of a fish cannery contract. Four prominent Bow Ons have been marked for killing, according to the whispered rumors of Chinatown and one of them has already been brought down. Lee Dai Hoy was killed two weeks ago. Lim Bin, who received the death slip and reading a lesson in Lee Dai Hoy's fate, has disappeared; Chin Hong, a big merchant here, who for protection, has sealed himself in his store building, an except for a trusted servant and the police, allows no one to go out or enter, and Hong Ging, another wealthy Chinaman, who took his death notice and slipped away from Portland and is supposed to be hiding in the timber land. An attempt was made to burn Ging's house but it failed. If the 19 San Francisco men get into Portland, declare the Bow Ons of the peace faction, many assassinations will surely be attempted.
