BIG WORSTED MILL IS COMING TO EAST PORTLAND

(East Portland People's Press.) The East Side will probably soon be the home of another new industry. If plans at present under consideration are carried through. The Peoples Press can authoritatively state that plans are now well under way for the construction and equipment, on the East Side, of a worsted mill which will use the wool of the sheep grown in the Willamette Valley. This wool is at present sent to New York and Boston, and is re-shipped to Great Britain to be made up into worsted yarn, from whence it comes back to the United States either as yarn or cloth. The gentlemen backing the present enterprise want to save this round-trip and the extra expense, and are therefore planning the equipment of a local worsted mill. The promoter of the enterprise is a man who has spent his entire life in the woolen manufacturing business, starting as a mere boy, and ending it until he finally completed his own factory in the East. Here he was, in fact, one of the power manufacturers of worsteds in Massachusetts, and on leaving the manufacturing end of the business came West and continued in the same line as a dealer in the material. He stands ready to practically his entire fortune in the new business on the East side, and will give his experience and knowledge as well. Other wool men are joined with him, and as much as can be arranged, it is believed that an announcement of the new plant can be made. The manufacture of worsted yarn is a steeper industry than ordinary cloth milling, as the product is of a higher grade and has a steadier demand. So called woolens of the present day are made largely from rags and general waste, and before the mills are glutted with material, and find prices so low that they remain but little profit. Worsteds, on the other hand, can only be made from the long staple fibres, and there is always a demand for it at a good price, and the supply is never sufficient. The country, therefore would be a substantial and paying one. Young men and girls are needed in the business, and in this way the establishment of a worsted mill will give employment to many of the local young people. In start-

ing the factory it will be necessary to bring from the East or from England skilled weavers, as the labor required is not common grade. Good wages will be paid, and the opening of the plant here should prove a general boon to the East Side and to the wool growers of the entire Willamette Valley. Final negotiations in the matter will probably be completed this month, and one of the firm will then leave at once for England to purchase the special machinery required for the weaving of worsted yarn.

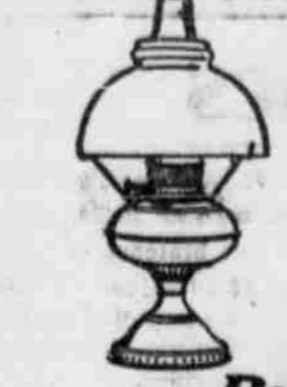
