an advanced age, married an English woman. Some years later he contracted a liaison with the duchess' maid, Fancesca Bughner. The duke, however, manifested strong religious tendencies and priests and monks were constantly at his house, one of them Father Valeriano, being eventually appointed chaplain. A few months later the duchess and her maid died suddenly. The control of the house passed thereup into the hands of Father Valeriano, who introduced into the household a Sicilian valet. The duke fell, the priest and the valet being in constant at-

tendance. Seeing that the end was near, the priest confessed the dying man and disappeared. Almost immediately the duke died.

When relatives went to the duke's house they found that it had been repossessed of all its costly treasure and jewels and the money box robbed. Suspicion at once attached to the priest and valet and they were arrested. In the former's cell at the San Pasquale monastery were found many articles that belonged to the duke and he could not account for a large sum of money that he had placed in the care of a friend. The valet accused the priest of having stolen \$125,000 from the duke, of which he admitted receiving \$7000 as hush money.

An examination of the bodies of the duke, his wife and the maid showed that the murdered trio had been poisoned.

Murders Brother.

Ivanica, Servia, April 17.—The wedding of Cana Kerotivitch, a peasant girl, to Bajin Kojopeltich ended in a terrible tragedy. The bride became engaged a year ago to the bridegroom's brother before he left home to do his military service duty. During his absence she transferred her affections to Bajin and finally agreed to marry him. The absent brother heard of his fiancée's faithlessness the day before the wedding, deserted his regiment. He arrived at the church during the ceremony, rushed up to the altar as his brother and the bride was answering the priest's questions and shot them. Bajin was killed and the bride badly wounded. The murdered escaped.
