FORTY THOUSAND CATHOLICS PARADE

(United Press Leased Wire.)
New York, April 28.—Following the saying of mass in celebrating the centennial anniversary of the founding of the New York diocese today the papal benediction sent through Archbishop Farley, was read by Mgr. Diomede Falconio, apostolic delegate to the United States.

A message of congratulation was received from President Roosevelt. Cardinal Gibbons, in a sermon preached by him, referred to the closer relations of the church and its leaders in the contest for American independence. Archbishop Logue, of Ireland, is one of the prelates attending the celebration. The original diocese had one church, three or four priests and 15,000 members. It has been divided into nine dioceses, with 120,000 members. New York city alone has 230 churches.

The celebration will end Saturday with a parade in which, it is expected, 40,000 Catholics will participate.

Insane Jan Kills Room Mate.

San Francisco, April 28.—Sobbing wildly, rolling over and over on the street and showing other apparent signs of mental disorder, Y. Nasua, a Japanese, was found on the corner of Devisadero and Hayes streets today. After investigation it was found he had fatally shot his room mate, K. Nakamura. As near as can be learned, the men had a quarrel last January and although they roomed together for the four months following their quarrel, they did not speak.

This morning the quarrel broke out afresh and Nasua drew a revolver, firing three shots at his companion, two taking effect in his shoulder and one entering the neck, taking an upward course and lodging in the brain.

But little hope is held out for Nakamura's recovery. Nasua is thought to be insane.

Actors Galore Out of Work.

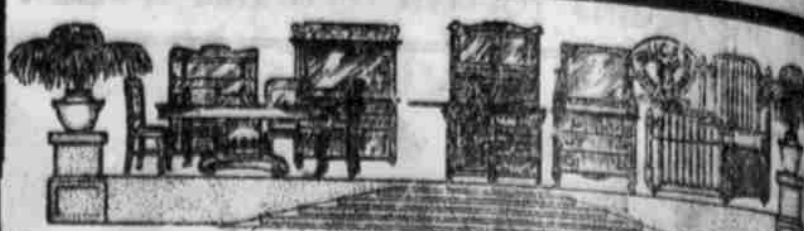

MAY STAMPEDE FOR ROOSEVELT

(United Press Leased Wire.)

Pittsburg, Penn., April 28.—Congressman Longworth, the President's son-in-law, hinted in an interview on politics that there is a strong likelihood of the Chicago convention stampeding in favor of President Roosevelt and in that event—well he wouldn't venture to say what might happen.

Longworth had been asked if there was the remotest sort of a probability that Roosevelt would accept the nomination.

"I am sure of one thing," answered the Ohio legislator, "that the President in sincere when he says he doesn't want another term, but if the convention should stampede

to him I positively cannot say what his attitude would be. If he has his own way about it, however, the nomination will not be forced upon him." Incidentally, Longworth announced he was out for Taft. He is to deliver an address here tonight at the American club banquet.
