NEGRO GIRL TO RETURN

Raised as White Child She Must Now Assimilate With Her Own Race.

(United Press Leased Wire.)
New York, April 28.—Christian League Woodyear, the negro girl adopted by Mrs. Elizabeth Grannis, president of the National Christian League for Purity, after 14 years of white child treatment, goes back to her own race. Mrs. Grannis has arranged with Booker T. Washington to Christian's admittance on July 1 in the celebrated negro institute at Tuskegee, Ala.

There is some difference of opinion as to whether Christian will take to the proposed change in her surroundings, for she has been reared by Mrs. Grannis as a white child. Enemies of Mrs. Grannis say she has made Christian's lot far harder than had she raised the child as a negro, with the proper respect for her own race.

Mrs. Grannis' negro ward became nationally famous when her adopted parents was arraigned before the head of her church upon the following charge: "That the said Elizabeth Grannis has treated the official board of the First Church of the Disciples of Christ with contempt, in that she refused to heed the request of the officers of the church that she either leave her young child protegee at one or else sit in the back part of the church; said request having been made by the officers after a formal resolution to this effect had been adopted by the official board, prompted by complaints made by members of the church sitting in the vicinity of the pew of the said Eliza-

beth Grannis to the effect that the unrestrained antics of the child were an annoyance that prevented them from properly enjoying worship in the church."

WOMEN DEMAND FREEDOM

St. Petersburg, April 28.—Because they think the Mohammedan members of the douma prefer bondage to freedom for their wives and daughters, Mussulman equal rights crusaders of Orenburg have sent a lobbyist to labor with the christian law makers in their behalf.

The Orenburg Mohammedan women recently petitioned their co-religionists among the lawmakers to "give them their rights" but they assert their plea has been wholly disregarded.

"Although our religion made us free," said the petition, "we are oppressed by our ignorant despots of husbands. Mussulman deputies: It is your duty to demand all rights for Mussulman women. If men do not change their attitude toward us the day will come when they, too, will be slaves and the whole Mussulman race will perish."

Washington, April 28.—Representative Olmstead, of the committee which is investigating the charge involving the Electric Boat company, surprised Representative Lilley's attorney, Frank L. Brown, of Connecticut, by declaring that his client may be called before the house and expelled. There has been a great deal of talk of the possibility of such extreme action, but this was the first intimation that had come from the committee itself. Mr. Lilley, himself, was not present. He is ill in his apartments at the New Willard, and it is said today that his physician will not allow him to attend any more of the hearings, so near to a complete nervous collapse is he as a result of the failure of the investigation.
