### BURGLARY AT BROCKWAY.

Postoffice and General Store Robbed of \$100.

At Brockway, eight miles southwest of Roseburg, Thursday night, burglars robbed the general store and postoffice conducted by I. B. Nichols. While the amount of their booty has not yet been figured up by Mr. Nichols, it will range around \$100 mark. No arrests have yet been made by the authorities, and so far as known, there is not the slightest clue as to the identity of the burglars. Entrance to the building was gained by sawing a hole in the rear door, enabling the lifting of the night latch on the inner side.

According to Mr. Nichols' estimates, the burglars stole about \$10 in coin and between \$10 and \$15 worth of stamps from the postoffice till; nearly \$12 in money from the store till; probably \$50 worth of merchandise, consisting of cutlery, cigars, cartridges, etc., and a district school warrant for \$40, which, of course, will prove of no value to the thieves unless they resort to forgery. In which event they would strengthen the chances of their capture.

For President, Best Man in the Nation.

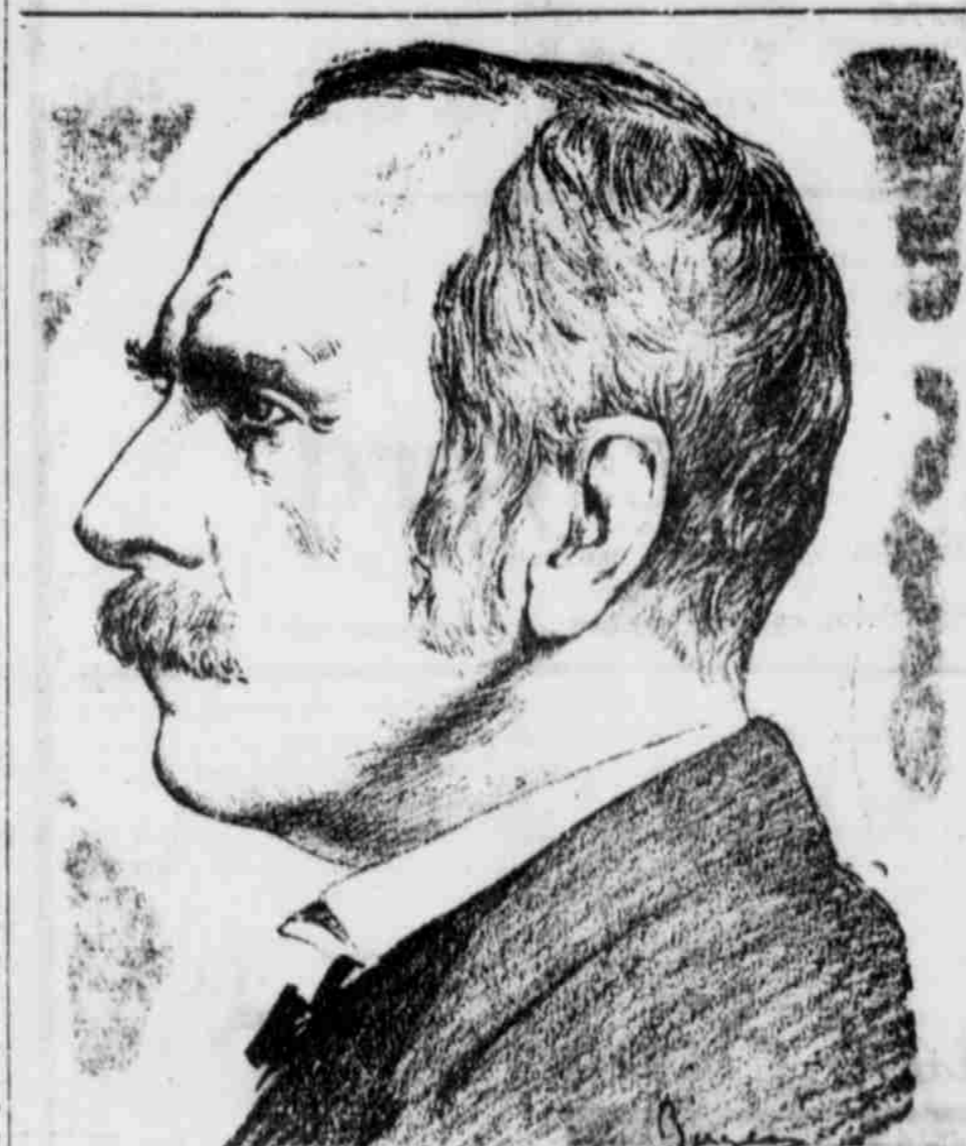
Washington, April 13.—Representative W. L. Jones is the first member of the Washington delegation in congress to declare himself openly and unreservedly in favor of the nomination of Secretary Taft. Mr. Jones today made the following statement:
