## PRESIDENT CLEVELAND IS BELIEVED TO BE NEAR DEATH

(United Press Leased Wire.)  
Lakewood, N. J., May 2.—The feeling is general here today that Grover Cleveland, the only living former President of the United States, is slowly sinking and that the end is approaching faster than either Mrs. Cleveland or Dr. Bryant, his physician, will admit.

Mrs. Cleveland refused to give the public any information concerning the condition of her husband and none can be obtained from Dr. Bryant, who refers all people to the patient's wife.

The secrecy being maintained leads to the belief that the former President is near death. Dr. Bryant remained at the bedside all night and this morning.

Princeton, N. J., May 2.—Mrs. Cleveland arrived here this afternoon. She declared that her husband is slowly recovering and that he will be out of bed in a few days. She declares there is no foundation for the report that there is danger in Mr. Cleveland's illness.

A penalty of \$5000 a day is fixed for every day of non-compliance with this law. Three or four separate suits will be brought at an early date to bring out all the points involved in each feature of this provision.

**To Dam Snake River.**  
President Roosevelt has agreed to sign the Snake river dam bill if it is amended so that not more than 25 per cent of the water of the dam shall be used for power purposes.

The agreement was reached at a conference attended by Senator Piles and Representative Jones of Washington. Another provision in the bill is after a lapse of 50 years the secretary of war will have absolute control of the dam now projected.

**Johnson Will Not Quit.**  
Chicago, May 2.—While Governor John A. Johnson of Minnesota is laying plans for the capture of the southern states not committed to W. J. Bryan, the followers of the latter are engaged in an earnest effort to take Johnson's own state away from him.

Johnson's hopes as a presidential candidate are bound up in the Minnesota convention's result. With that convention lost, Johnson is lost.

The governor declared today that there shall be no compromise with the Bryan men and that the fight must go on to the finish.

**Wins Labor Victory.**  
Indianapolis, Ind., May 2.—James Lewis, the new president of the United Mine Workers of America, has won his first big victory since he became the head of the organization. As a result of his efforts, the recent contract between him and the operators at Toledo, providing that the contract between the mine owners and operators will run two years at the present wage scale, has been accepted by members of both organizations.
