Notice is hereby given that at the adopted to improve Winter street in the city of Salem, Oregon, including intersection, from the north side of North Mill Creek bridge to No. 14 .- 9:13 P. M. Portland Er the Fair Ground road in said city, in the following manner:

First, by placing in tiling not less than 24 inches in circumference across said Winter street where said Winter street is intersected by the north line of North street; where it is intersected by both the north and south line of Market street, and where it is intersected by the south line of the Fair Ground road.

Second, by establishing the grade and by grading and filling the said to conform to said grade, except as mentioned in paragraph three here-of, with full intersections.


