There has been no such assemblage of monarchs since the congress ago when the map of Europe was re-arranged AFTER NAPOLEON HAD TANGLED ITS BOUNDARIES.

The city was magnificently decorated.

Flags and bunting stretched across the streets and public buildings, private houses and office structures had their fronts emblazoned in a mass of color.
