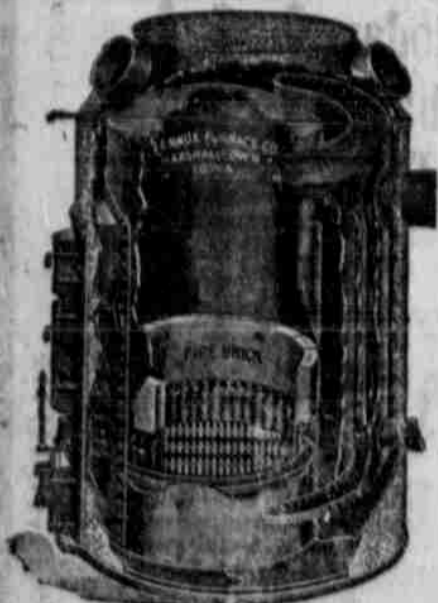

EXPENSIVE MUNICIPAL BUILDINGS.

Chicago is having a rather enlightening experience just now. While the old city hall is in process of demolition, preparatory to the erection of a new building, the city departments have been obliged to seek quarters in a modern office building. Now the owner of an office building not only has to pay for maintenance and repairs and insurance and interest on investment, just as the city of Chicago does on all its public buildings but he has also to pay taxes and water rates. These are items of considerable moment not included in the cost of running public buildings. And yet the Chicago departments find themselves able to rent commodious quarters in a private building, with more floor space than in the Old City hall, for less money than it cost to run that building. The item of rent will now be less than it cost merely to light and heat the City Hall.

The explanation of this remarkable condition, of course, lies in the fact that the private owner runs his building economically and efficiently at the lowest practicable cost. The city, on the other hand, is without the incentive of personal profit and runs its building on a lavish and loose scale. More men are hired than are necessary, in order to have a long pay roll for the politicians' benefit, and higher wages are paid than are necessary. The city's employees have the loafing habit, and, feeling secure in their positions, have no interest in saving the city's money.

A comparison of our own great public building and the cost of running it with any of the better class office buildings of the city, would, beyond question, show that Chicago has no monopoly of municipal extravagance in that direction. The worst of it is that the difficulty seems so hopeless. No remedy is in sight—unless, perchance, it is the Des Moines or Galveston commission plan.—Minneapolis Journal.
