SHOWS AND SUMMER FURNISHINGS

Delightful Housekeeping—Devices that Tempt People to Certain Out-Doors—Verandas.

York, May 16.—Now that the new season is fashionable, it is possible to be at once comfortable, artistic, and smart in one's living, at a very moderate expense since the new type of cottages, less to build and furnish than the old, is known heretofore, perhaps the ugly camp meeting that was formerly almost a solution for inexpensive quarters and these did not differ in the same class in any particular lines of the bungalow with the natural surroundings of shore, wooded back-woods, or grassy downs, in a manner a delight to the eye, while the interior is possible in even a small house, since provision is made for very few rooms which cuts down expense but adds to the comfort and ease of living. Fittings that are neither cheap in appearance nor flimsy in construction, but rather built to answer the requirements of substantial country living where the boys come in from golf or more practical digging and throw themselves into an easy chair with small thought or care for floor coverings or chair cushions.

Washable Coverings.

Most of the coverings for upholstery or lounging purposes are made of washable fabrics, and to meet the demand manufacturers have made quantities of very substantial cotton materials that are exactly suited for couch covers and chair cushions. Denham is one of the cheapest and

best of these and admits of very effective decoration in stencilled patterns and simple outline embroideries and appliques. A material known as "Arras" makes excellent covers and comes in a number of desirable shadings in soft blues, greens and browns.

Floor Coverings.

Oster Refuted Conclusively.

The Flower hospital in Manhattan is an institution of homeopathy. In the same borough is the Homeopathic college, of which Dr. William H. King is the dean. That physician very lately experimented upon a dog with an electric current, to see if insensibility and the extinction of feeling could be produced by electricity, instead of the use of ether or chloroform as an anesthetic. The experiment is declared by the Tribune to have been entirely successful. When the electric current was disconnected, the animal was not apparently affected by the experience to which it had been subjected.

The experiment comprised shaving the hair off the top of the dog's head and on the back, near the tail, above the lumbar region. The dog became unconscious in 45 seconds. He could be handled without the least danger of awakening him. No operation was performed. When the current was removed the animal at once regained consciousness and activity, and was as lively as before the current was turned on. Not the least ill effect was apparent.

If this substitution of electricity for ether or chloroform can be made prevalent, the importance of the discovery cannot be overstated. It sufficiently disposes of the lately revived criticism by Dr. Oster, to the effect that the homeopaths are not scientific, do not belong to any scientific school, and have no part in modern science of medicine. Dr. Oster is apparently both prejudiced and uninformed on the side which he turns toward homeopathy and
