ANTI-GRAFT GOVERNOR NEEDED

The people will approve the decision of Governor Chamberlain to not resign as Governor, even if he is elected U. S. senator.

Some Republicans are urging that as soon as he is elected senator he should immediately resign as governor and make a place for a "Good Republican."

A machine organization will override the vetoes of any governor but the mere presence of such a man in the executive chair will keep the machine from undertaking many things it would otherwise put through IN THE FORM OF GRAFTS AND GRABS.

A Republican governor who would make the same kind of a record Chamberlain has made, and EVEN MORE TENACIOUS OF THE RIGHTS OF THE PEOPLE to common decency at the hands of the legislature would be appreciated by the rank and file of the Republican party.

It is a misnomer to call a man a good Republican who stands in to put through all kinds of skin-games, official pass bills, GIGANTIC LOG-ROLLING LEGISLATIVE COMBINES, and clerkship grafts.

The Republican state platform indirectly condemned several reform measures, and DIRECTLY DECLARED AGAINST a number of reforms that the people have enacted into laws.

If a Republican legislature undertakes to carry out the state platform, what is the duty of a governor in the premises? WOULD IT BE GOOD REPUBLICANISM TO STAND BY THE PARTY AS AGAINST THE PEOPLE?

Governor Chamberlain will do well to keep his hand on the veto club as long as the legislature is in session, and about ten days after. The people need the protection of a governor who is with them and against the machine.
