

LINGOLN COUNTY GETS TWO HIGH SCHOOLS

As Result of Wise Action of County Commissioners On Popular Vote

According to the following account from the Yaquina Bay News-Leader, Toledo and Newport are both to have high schools:

Last Friday as a day of chuck full of interest to the people of Newport and Toledo in particular and the county in general. That was the day the commissioner's court convened to act upon the matter of establishing a county high school, as was determined by a majority vote at the late election. There were two aspirants for the school—Newport and Toledo.

Both parties had delegations in attendance, and both parties felt themselves entitled to the school but were a little doubtful as to how the court would decide is pressed to a vote. This element of uncertainty put both parties on their good behavior and the conference was marked by, apparently, the most friendly feeling. After the court had listened to the arguments and suggestions of the representatives of the

two towns they offered to compromise the matter by leaving the question of establishing a permanent site to the voters of the county, and as a vote cannot be taken until November, 1910, they offered to assist the school boards in both Newport and Toledo to maintain high schools by appropriating \$300 to each board to pay the salaries of the principals in the high school departments.

This proposition appeared to be satisfactory to both delegations. We think this was the best thing the court could have done. This plan will give the county two high schools instead of one at a minimum of cost. There is another feature of this action that in our opinion will result in benefit to the county.

Newport and Toledo both hope to land the prize two years from now; their chances will hang on the character of their high schools—the one that gives the best service will then stand the best show with the voters. Go in, gentlemen, and do your best.
