Sealed proposals for drugs, dry goods, groceries, butter, leather and findings, hardware, flour and meat will be received at the office of the superintendent of the state penitentiary, until Friday, June 26th at 2 o'clock p. m., at which time they

will be opened. A deposit of \$200 in cash or certified check, payable to the superintendent, must accompany each bid for meat and flour, and all other bids must be accompanied by an amount equal to 10 per cent of the amount of the bld.

Samples to accompany all bids where practicable. The right is reserved to reject any and all bids and to accept or reject any portion of a bid. On each envelope should be inscribed the nature of the bid. Goods of Oregon manufacture or production will receive preference, other things being equal.

All goods and supplies must be delivered to the penitentiary within twenty (20) days after the contract is awarded.


