A fine sample of Kentucky blue stem wheat was today brought in to the Salem Board of Trade room from the Stringer farm four miles east of the city. It is over six feet tall, and many estimate the heavy heads will produce at least 60 bushels to the acre. Many rare samples of grasses, grains and fruits are coming in, and they attract a great deal of attention among newcomers. The farmers are all invited to send or bring in their finest samples, as these things are needed to perfect the permanent exhibits. Full credit will be given all who bring in specimens, and they will be helping the entire country by their efforts.

Supreme Court Decisions.

Following decisions were handed down by the supreme court yesterday:

Pacific Livestock Company v. Wm. M. Isaacs; appealed from Malheur county; reversed and remanded in an opinion by Commissioner Slater.

W. J. May v. Reuben Emerson; appealed from Baker county; reversed in an opinion by Justice Eakin.

Samuel Alderson v. E. G. Lee; appealed from Josephine county; affirmed in an opinion by Commissioner King.

State v. Roy Fuller; appealed from Baker county; reversed and remanded for new trial in an opinion by Justice Moore.
