

BIG BOOSTERS CONGRESS WILL MEET AT GOOS BAY

Mr. Lyon has inaugurated a congress of prominent men from all parts of the state to meet at Coos Bay the latter part of August and discuss the needs of Oregon in all lines and the best way of securing

them. It is for this purpose that he is personally visiting many of the towns of the Willamette valley. At this congress will be discussed many measures, such as dredging, draining and the raising of the various crops.
