SLAUGHTER HOUSES ARE UNSANITARY

In his report for the period ending July 31, Stock Inspector Keeler of Marion county states that most of the slaughter houses in the county are unsanitary. He says:

"I have visited most of the slaughter houses of this country, probably those that I did not visit are in the best sanitary condition, they being rather difficult to find, being only marked by three poles, pulleys and rope, the only roof being the sky and the clouds.

"I have found in two of the slaughter houses, one at Woodburn, and one at Salem, screened rooms for the cooling of slaughtered meat; one of these rooms was out of repair and not answering the purpose for which it was intended."

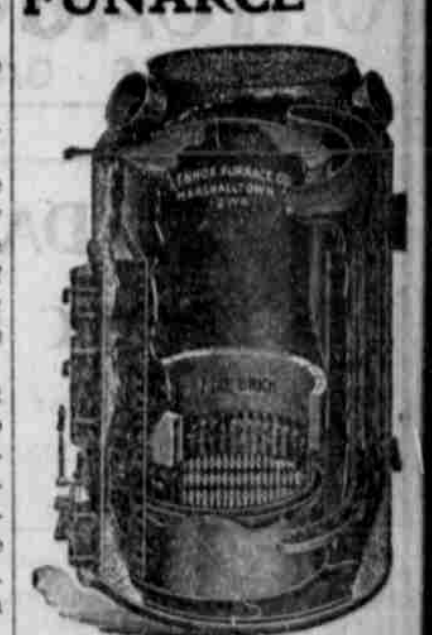
