Wheeling, W. Va., Sept. 1.—Senator Nathan Bay Scott of West Virginia today carries a badly-scarred countenance as the result of a flat encounter with former State Senator S. G. Smith in the Dollar Savings & Trust building of this city.

Some time ago, in an address at Parkersburg, Smith declared that the United States senatorship in West Virginia had been bought at public auction for many years. Scott and Smith met in the bank yesterday and when the former called upon Smith to deny his statement, the latter refused whereupon the U. S. senator applied to him the "shorter and uglier" word.

The two gentlemen then cleared for action and before they were separated, it is said they exchanged 36 blows, the great bulk of which went to the credit of Smith.

Cashier L. F. Stifel of the bank, finally was successful as a mediator and the combatants were led away. Scott's face was badly damaged, but Smith escaped with only a scratch.

A reward of \$1000 has been offered for trace of him by his relatives and no efforts are being spared to learn his whereabouts. His young wife is prostrated with grief at the home of the lawyer's parents in Chicago. Bethune was last seen in Buffalo, and from his actions there it is thought he intended coming to San Francisco.

## MINISTERS AID GRAFT PURGERS

(United Press Leased Wire.)

San Francisco, Sept. 1.—The Protestant ministry of San Francisco today rallied to the support of the graft prosecution by pledging attendance at the trials now in progress. To show their good faith in this, several clergymen were present at the proceedings in the Ruel case today.

The new determination of the preachers followed an address delivered before the citizens league of justice yesterday by Prof. R. H. Boke of the University of California. Boke flayed the court systems by which judges and juries can be led astray by conniving attorneys and spoke of the necessity of creating a public sentiment against the perversion of justice in this way. Walter MacArthur, a prominent labor leader, also spoke along the same lines.

The meeting was attended by 100 ministers, who unanimously verified their condemnation of graft prosecution and said they will attend the trials for the purpose of encouraging the prosecutors.

## EUGENE HOP-GROWERS MEET —FIX PRICE FOR PICKERS

(Eugene Register.)

The hop growers of this section met in convention at the court house yesterday afternoon at 1 o'clock and there was a large representation of growers.

The matter which came up for discussion first was the price to be paid for picking and it was unanimously agreed that there should be a uniform price paid. Owing to present market conditions it was deemed advisable not to pay more than 75 cents per hundred pounds and that was the uniform price agreed upon.

From remarks made at the meeting it is quite probable that a number of growers will not pick their crop this year.

A number of growers of early hops are now picking the crop and find it a little shy, they are paying 75 cents per 100 lbs.

Picking of the late crop will probably be commenced about September 10.

It is thought that only about 50 per cent of the hops raised here will be picked. There is nothing definite about the price that will be paid for hops as yet, but it will not exceed eight or nine cents at the start.

## TO SUE COPPER KING FOR HUNDRED THOUSAND

(United Press Leased Wire.)

San Francisco, Sept. 1.—Dr. E. B. Perrin is awaiting the return from Honolulu of Colonel W. C. Greene, the copper king of Mexico, to serve papers in a suit against him for the recovery of \$112,000 for 32,000 acres of land in Arizona for which the defendant is alleged to have contracted.

Papers in the case have been filed in the United States circuit court and will be served upon Greene upon his arrival here. The transaction upon which suit is brought is alleged by Perrin to have taken place at Cananean in the state of Sonora, Mexico, and concerned a tract of land that lies along the Babacomari river. Perrin claims that Greene promised to pay for the land upon the delivery to him of an authenticated deed and that this was done on May 12, 1908.
