FIGHTING CHOLERA

IN RUSSIA (United Press Leased Wire.) St. Petersburg, Sept. 21.—Premier Stolypin today personally assumed charge of the cholera situation here.

His first act was the removal of a number of incompetent authorities, and the creation of new sanitary districts.

The premier then ordered the sale of liquor restricted, and the stricken districts of the city policed with regularity and rigor.

More nurses were stricken today, and the situation is hourly growing worse. All ordinary patients have been turned away from the hospital;

Thousands of people are leaving the city, the exodus being particularly heavy among well-to-do classes.

An official order, presumably emanating from the czar that all bodies of cholera victims are to be cremated instead of buried, was given out today.

It is generally admitted that there are at least 4000 cases of cholera in St. Petersburg alone.

It is alarmed because of the appearance of the disease among the population surrounding Tsarkoe Selo, the czar's summer place.
