ULRICH FUEGY, OF PHILLIPS, DEAD

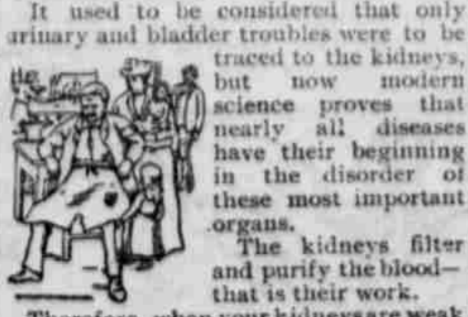
