 before the American Friends' society.

Viscount Kaneko took the position that after the demonstration of friendship between America and Japan, an American fleet in the Pacific ocean could not be considered by Japan as inimicable to her interests.

He mentioned the cry of the "White Man's" pacific that was raised in Australia and declared that only necessity of an American fleet in the Pacific would be to preserve peace and not to act against any single nation.

"A powerful naval force is necessary to maintain peace in the Pacific ocean," said the viscount, "and if the United States maintains this force, it will relieve Japan of the necessity of further naval expansion and the consequent financial burden it entails."

Admiral Sperry bid farewell to Tokio this afternoon, going to Yokohama. He was represented at the entertainment given by Viscount Kaneko by Admiral Emory.

The reception was held in the rooms of the Maple club and was the last entertainment of the celebration at Tokio.

A reception to the American fleet officers on board Admiral Togo's famous flagship Mikasa was the feature of tonight's celebration at Yokohama. Admiral Sperry was the guest of honor at the reception and an informal smoker that followed.

In order that Japan may have her promised week of entertainment for the American fleet, the ships will not sail until Sunday instead of leaving Saturday afternoon as was planned. All the admirals except Admiral Emory left for Yokohama with Admiral Sperry.

The last function of the fleet will be a reception by Admiral Sperry on board the flagship Connecticut in Yokohama bay.

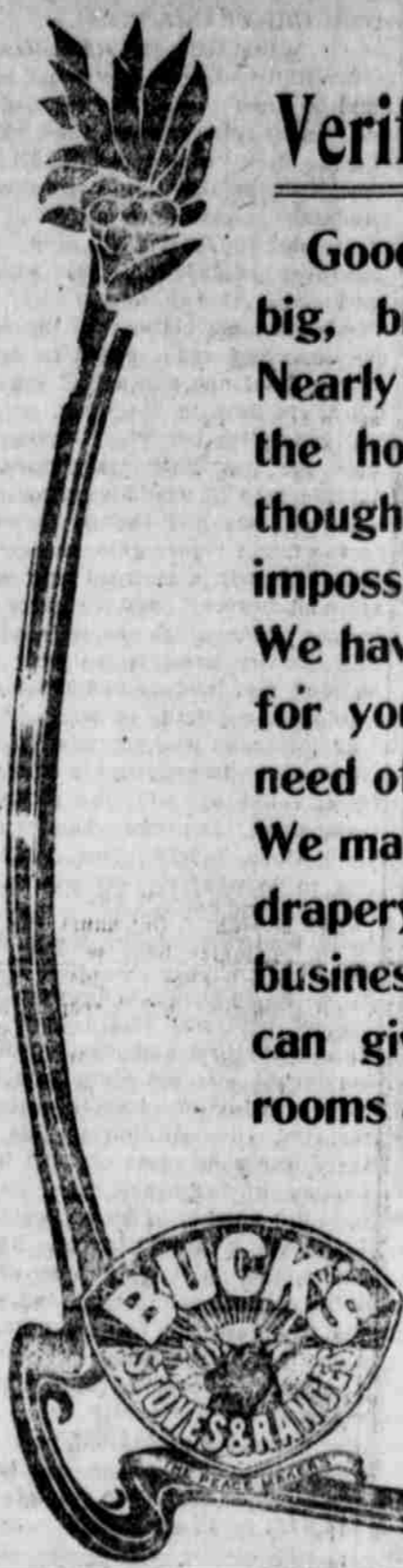
