There were 2000 yards of rock crushed, and the cost per yard was 95 cents.

At the next meeting of the county court the problem now facing the county regarding the allotments to the various districts for road building will be the main issue. During the past month Judge Busbey has been compelled to turn applications for funds away owing to the expense of road building and improvement being exhausted. The number of applications coming ready for improvement of highways in the many districts alone would

aggregate in the thousands of dollars, and many of those asking for help along this line, have had no assistance this year at all, and for this reason the court will endeavor to remedy the present system of distribution of road funds and equalize the matter as much as possible. Under the system which the funds have been distributed now, equal taxation in uniform with the cost of maintaining the property amount given each district, is nearly impossible owing to the many variations in the taxes.
