ARE JURY TRIALS DESCENDING INTO A FARCE?

Under the presence of sensational journalism and arbitrary rulings of judges in some cases, jurors are losing their sense of duty in the trial of accused men AND MAKING SUCH TRIALS A FARCE.

Many persons who read the trial of Martin for the Wolf murder must have come to the conclusion that the verdict was a compromise compelled by popular clamor, AND THAT HE WAS NOT CONVICTED BEYOND A REASONABLE DOUBT.

The newspapers in such cases, proceed from the start on the theory of guilt from which there is no escape.

A juror in the Lathrop case in private conversation stated that a number of jurors when ballots were taken voted blank in order to see what the majority of the jury would decide upon AND THEN PROCEEDED TO VOTE WITH THE MAJORITY.

Such practices give the accused man no more protection than he would have at the hands of an infuriated mob.

When a juror lays aside his right to a private judgment and submits to the determination of a majority, he deprives an accused man of his constitutional rights AND PUTS JUSTICE ON THE BLOCK OF A POPULAR VOTE.

This destroys the very principle of jury trials—that a man shall be convicted to the satisfaction of twelve of his peers, beyond any reasonable doubt.

N ACCUSED MAN IS ENTITLED TO THE BENEFIT OF ONE JUROR'S DOUBT.

When that one man submits his doubt under the will of a majority, no matter how great, he is depriving the accused of the protection of law and making justice a mockery.

GOD GIVES US MEN, MEN WHO HAVE A MIND BASED ON INDIVIDUAL CONCEPTIONS OF RIGHT AND WRONG, and not the truckling cringing creatures who seek to conform their minds to others!

In matters of right and justice, in matters of life and liberty, a majority is not in numbers.

AND WITH GOD, WITH JUSTICE, WITH RIGHT IS A MAJORITY.

Too many men in these days condemn and find men guilty because of the clamor of the press that brands any man guilty from the moment he is accused.

Such newspapers never undo the wrong they do. They never right the injury they have inflicted.

WITH JURORS SUBJECTED TO SUCH INFLUENCES the administration of justice becomes an invasion of the liberty of the individual and renders the constitutional right to a fair trial an impossibility.
