COURT HOUSE NEWS

A decision was handed down by Judge Burnett yesterday at noon on a few cases which he had under advisement.

The matter of Claggett vs. Yankke settled by a remittitur of a portion of the judgment arrived at in the verdict handed in by the jury a short time ago.

In the case involving the estate of Carl Walker, deceased, vs. Marie Walker, administratrix, Marie Walker's attorney, Geo. H. Bingham, made motion to modify the judgment made for the plaintiff, B. E. Miller, the last trial for \$35, but Judge Burnett overruled it. Carson & Brown appear as counsel for the plaintiff.

In the action for money instigated by M. Christenson against D. Morgan, Voget and G. Voget, an appealed case, Judge Burnett ruled that on payment of \$5 to the plaintiff, the defendant would be allowed to file a second amended answer on or before the 12th of November, the plaintiff answer same the 20th of the same month. Attorney Frank Holmes appears for the plaintiff, and Martin & Hitzel for the defendant.

G. B. Cellars was given judgment with an order to sell attached property belonging to Emil Schindler to recover payment on some promissory notes. Attorney Hetzel handled the case for Schindler.
