REID IS OUT TO SUPPLANT PLATT

New York, Nov. 5.—Members of the Republican committee here today say that Whitelaw Reid, American ambassador to Great Britain, is a candidate for the United States senate to succeed Senator Platt. The feud between Reid and Platt is one of long standing, and politicians who are acquainted with the enmity between the two men say that Reid will find considerable difficulty in supplanting the former boss.

When President McKinley was elected, Reid, who had been ambassador to France under President Harrison, sought the post at King Edward's court. He was opposed by Senator Platt, who succeeded in preventing his election. Reid was named as ambassador to Great Britain by Roosevelt.

Since the Platt incident he has had little love for New York's senior member of the upper house.

Among the candidates for the senate, besides Reid, are former Governor Frank S. Black, Congressman J. Sloat Fassett and Timothy L. Woodstate committee. The Republican caucus that will select Senator Platt's successor promises to be a lively gathering.
