## CHARGED WITH MURDER OF 50

Wallace, Ida., Nov. 11.—Facing the charge of committing at least 50 murders and innumerable robberies, two men giving the names of A. J. Manning and O. B. Bliss, said to be members of a gang of desperadoes, are under heavy guard in jail here today, for it is feared that an attempt will be made by their confederates to liberate them.

The charge that led directly to their arrest is that of passing forged checks on railroad contractors. After searching the records of the two prisoners, however, the police were convinced that they are members of a gang that operated in construction camps and murdered 50 workmen between Grand Forks, Idaho, and Taft, Mont., in each instance robbery was the motive.

All these dead men were found, sometimes as many as three in a day with skulls crushed and pockets turned out. The theory advanced by the police is strengthened by the fact that the prisoners own a trunk in which the police found wigs, false mustaches, a complete set of burglar's tools, stolen mining stock and a rubber stamp for forging checks. The police authorities are elated over the capture, for they think a great deal of their worry is over now.

## ROOSEVELT KNOWS ALL ABOUT AFRICA

(United Press Leased Wire.) Philadelphia, Pa., Nov. 11.—That President Roosevelt is the best informed man in America on Africa, is the statement made today by Harry Johnston, the famous scientist, explorer and author. He talked with the president at the White House several days ago and says that he could tell Roosevelt very little about the country to which he is going on his hunting trip.

Johnston went to the White House soon after he returned here recently from a trip to Africa. He had heard that the president contemplated going to Africa and wanted to be of any assistance that he could in giving information as to the country and its natives.

He says that when he talked with Roosevelt, he discovered that the president had read all the authorities on Africa and was well posted as to everything.

"The only points that I could give the President any information on were minor things, such as where to get horses and provisions and what foods to prepare for the various expeditions," said Johnston today. "The President knew all about the country, the natives and the trails and the varieties of animals. He taught me some things."
