Attorney Winslow for the plaintiff based his argument on the fact, and called witnesses to testify, that it was Long's dog which did the deed, and notwithstanding a few witnesses confessed the Long dog was in evidence, to firmly implicate that particular creature with the trouble, was very difficult for Attorney Winslow.

TO TEACH RIGHT WAY OF LIVING

Chicago, Nov. 12.—"The league of Right Living" is the name of a new cult which Bishop Fallows of St. Paul's Reformed Episcopal church announces today, will be started all over the United States.

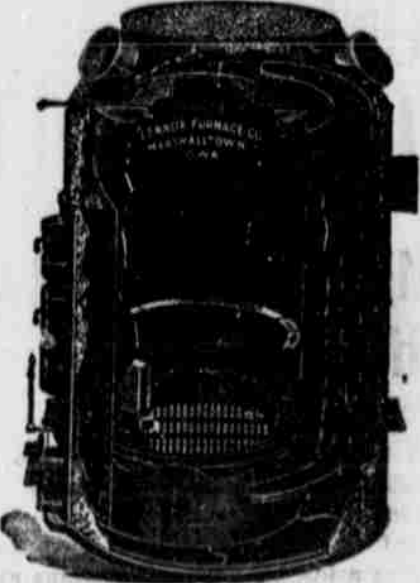
