## SALEM MAN GOT A LETTER WON A HEART AND FORTUNE

Following is a love letter that was written to a Salem man who was in the Salmon river mines in Idaho in the early sixties. It is needless to say it was written by a Salem lady who may now be a grandmother. She was proud of her lover and whether they were ever united or not, it has the ring of honest and true womanhood, and deserves to rank with a collection of love letters of famous literary persons. It will be noticed that news in those days was news even when it was a year old, and that fathers were in the habit of opening their daughters' letters.

### Here is the Letter.

Salem, Ore., Aug. 5, 1862. Dear William.—I received your kind letter of the 4th of July. I was glad to hear from you. You wanted me to come up to Lewiston, and you would meet me there. You know that I could not. How would I get away from here? I would like to be up there with you, but I cannot go up there all alone, and you have sold your claim, and you come down. Now you said, write to you what Presley was doing. He has moved up on his place and he is harvesting down here. The time has seemed long since I have last seen you. I wish that you was here with me, or that I was with you. If I was with you I would be as happy as a queen.

If I ever prove false to you, the elements shall fall, my love, the sea shall rage and burn, the fire shall freeze like ice, my love. There is the crow so very black shall surely turn to white, if ever I prove false to you, bright day shall turn to night. There is the lark; the eagle and the sparrow, too; what might I care for this whole world if I only was married to you. Your eyes are of the sparkling blue, your lips like rubies be; there is not one fault within my love that mortal eye can see.

Aunt Sarah Plowman is dead. She died the 30th of July. And Lucretia Steen is dead. She died the 1st of August. The folks are all well. Aunt Sarah Dublin says tell you when you come back, and you and me get married, she has some currants and blackberries for us put up in cans. She said send her respects to you. The first letter you wrote me father got it out of the postoffice. He opened it and read it before he fetched it home to me. Write to me when you are coming home. I want you to send me your likeness and if you want mme send me the money to have it taken with. Send yours in the next letter you write. You know father won't let me have mine taken to send up there. I have no more to write at present. Write as soon as you get this. No more.

It might be added that the man who got this letter made a small fortune in the Idaho mines and came back to Salem and helped erect the Starkey block and became one of the capitalists of the city.
