San Francisco, Nov. 15.—The police today are seeking trace of the two white masked thugs who held up and robbed Mrs. Elmer Rooker last night. The victim of the footpads had no money on her at the time of the attack but two diamond rings were torn from her fingers before the men were frightened away. Mrs. Rooker was near her home when the holdup occurred. She saw two men ahead of her and when she turned them saw that their faces were masked with white handkerchiefs. Neither displayed a revolver but told her to keep quiet or they would kill her.

Mrs. Rooker pleaded in vain with the thugs not to molest her, declaring that she had no money. After they had searched her, one of the robbers tore two diamond rings from her fingers and both fled. The police were notified soon afterward but no trace of the thieves was found.
