YOUNG MAN ASSAULTED BY ROBBERS

Frank Guild, a young man who has quarters on the second floor of the Barnes Cash Store, was assaulted by two unknown men Sunday morning about 2 o'clock who afterward made good their escape from the police.

Guild was not aware of the intruders until he first opened his eyes, and then he was given no opportunity of acting further in his own defense, as a vicious blow upon the forehead by what he supposed to be a slug shot, stunned him. After he came too, he at once notified Mr. Barnes and together they returned to the store where the night officers were searching for the burglars, but no sign of them could be found by the officers in the store.

The police are under the impression the two men were in the store in hiding when the establishment was closed for the night, and when all was quiet, began their work. A long piece of iron used on freight cars for the purpose of holding brake blocks in place, was found in the bed where Guild was attacked, but from the slight presence of blood upon it, it could not be probable that the dangerous looking piece of steel was used on the victim as the means to knock him senseless.

SECOND BRIDGE ACCIDENT

TEAM GOES THRO' DEATH TRAP.

As a result of the buggy parting last night, a team belonging to the Low stables took fright on South Commercial street and ran through the South Commercial street bridge, cutting and bruising them up considerably.

A man by the name of Meyers was driving the team at the time, and was descending the hill about two blocks from the bridge, when in some unknown manner, the reach which holds the running gears of the rig together, came loose, letting the back portion of the buggy fall to the ground with the occupants in it. The team, which are very gentle ordinarily, became frightened at the sudden falling of the parted rig, and ran down the street on the east side and coming to the guard for keeping teams off this portion of bridge, managed to get over it and fell into the large holes where plank has been removed.

The lady and her daughter who were in the rig were thrown out in the mud but not badly hurt. This is the second team to go through that bridge.
