THE OPEN FORUM

To the Editor:—In the constitution of the United States we read as follows: "The senate of the United States shall be composed of two senators from each state, chosen by the legislatures thereof for six years, etc." Art 1, Section 3, of U. S. constitution.

"The time, place and manner of holding elections for senators and representatives shall be prescribed in each state by the legislatures thereof, etc." Art 1, Section 4.

"The electors (presidential) shall meet in their respective states and vote by ballot for president and vice-president, etc., etc." Art 12, U. S. constitution.

Those that ask the Statement No 1 members of our legislature to violate their pledges, claims that the election of Geo. E. Chamberlain to the U. S. senate will be contrary to the U. S. constitution. There is nothing contrary to the constitution in the election of Governor Chamberlain to the U. S. senate, only it is contrary to the perverted minds of dishonest politicians.

But let us, for the sake of argument, admit that the legislative assembly has no constitutional right to elect the one nominated by the voters of a sovereign state, then the members of the electoral college will violate the constitution if they vote for Wm. Taft and J. S. Sherman, who were nominated by a political convention, under the whips of the political boss of the White House.

Technically the Statement No. 1 members of the legislature may not have to vote for Geo. E. Chamberlain; neither are the members of the electoral college technically bound to vote for Wm. Taft and J. S. Sherman; but, in both cases, they are morally bound to stay with their pledges. The cases are parallel.

If the advocates of dishonest politics are consistent, they should advise all the Republican electors to vote for Bryan and Kern and, there by avoid violating the U. S. constitution.

Of course, these lovers of the constitution are making the excuse that Senator Fulton was beaten by a trick and Mr. Calkins was nominated on the Republican ticket. Senator Fulton was beaten by the authorities in Washington, assisted by F. Heney, who made a lot of charges and then failed to make good.

The fact is that the voters of Oregon vote for George E. Chamberlain as often as he runs. The voters of Oregon love George E. for the enemies he has made.

EVANGELIST SPEAKS TO LARGE AUDIENCE

Professor Shaffer sang one of his touching solos and the chorus and congregation made melody in song. At the afternoon service of young people a number responded to the invitation to become Christians.

There have been sixteen added, who have been members elsewhere, and 18 who have expressed a desire to become Christians. Altogether, Mr. Small says, there is an opening for a great revival in our city.
