It is a cruel shame to take candy from babies.
But it isn't a circumstance to the way the wool is pulled OVER THE PEOPLE'S EYES IN OREGON.
Here we are, a great commonwealth with only one large city, WITH ONLY ONE MORNING NEWSPAPER IN THAT CITY.
An address is published in that paper as delivered before the State Bar Association.
That address propounds to be an argument against the direct legislative system ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF OREGON.
It is supposed to be a learned, able, disinterested presentation of an important matter and is commended editorially.
But gaze behind the scene with us and ask a few whys and wherefores.

By so doing it deceives its readers.
The Grangers of Oregon initiated a law to tax telegraph, telephone and express companies on their gross earnings.
ALSO TO TAX THE STANDARD OIL AND PULLMAN SLEEPING CAR COMPANIES. THAT LAW WAS ENACTED.
Those corporations band together to resist and defeat payment of this tax and hire this lawyer to plead their case.
They have a perfect right to do this.
They are carrying their suit to defeat the Direct Legislation amendment to the Supreme Court of the United States.
THEY HAVE A PERFECT RIGHT TO DO THAT ALSO.
But why deceive the people by concealing the facts, the interests, the motives of the lawyer who presents the argument?
WHY NOT TELL THE PEOPLE THIS IS THE HIRED ATTORNEY OF THE INTERESTS WHO IS SPEAKING?
Instead of palming it off on the unsuspecting people of Oregon as learned legal lore, why not tell them THIS IS ROTTEN ROT, PAID FOR BY THE PULLMAN PALACE CAR COMPANY AND JOHN D. ROCKEFELLER?
These corporations could never be taxed on their gross earnings by a legislature.
BUT THE PEOPLE FOUND A WAY TO REACH THEM.
So the system of Direct Legislation must be battered down.

THE FARMERS RAISE THE TAXES BY THE SWEAT OF THEIR BROWS.

The gross earnings tax must be defeated or the Pullmans and Platts and Rockefellers and Calhouns WILL HAVE TO PAY TO SUPPORT THE STATE GOVERNMENT.
Direct Legislation is dangerous to the big interests.
The people must be deceived BY THE MONOPOLISTIC ORGAN OF WHOLESALE DECEPTION.
It would never do to tell them that this address attacking Direct Legislation was delivered by the chief counsel of the interests attacked by Direct Legislation.
THE PEOPLE ARE NOT FIT TO KNOW THE TRUTH, is the theory of the chief organ of the great bunko game of political Ananiasism at Portland, Oregon.
But there is not so much ignorance among the people as these voracious of the predatory interests suppose.
It is just such conduct as this on the part of a press monopoly that has compelled the people to take the legislative power into their own hands in Oregon.
It is such deceptions and betrayals of public trust that has DESTROYED CONFIDENCE IN OUR LEGISLATURES.
The people said, Our representatives will not place taxation where it belongs.
WE WILL DO A LITTLE TAXING OURSELVES. WE WILL NOT BEAR ALL THE BURDENS.
Hence the organs of the interests cry down this system, and seek to establish the idea that such legislation by the people is dangerous and unconstitutional.
But the people of Oregon know how helpless they are to secure justice in the legislature and the federal courts.
THEY KNOW THAT THE LEGISLATURES AND CONGRESS AND THE FEDERAL COURTS ARE THE HIDING PLACES OF CORPORATIONS.
The people know that they have little or nothing to expect from the highest supreme court.
But the court that once upheld slavery, that defeated the income tax law, THAT SET ASIDE THE STANDARD OIL DECISION, there is little to hope from the last court of appeals.
The people will wait the outcome of the litigation against the gross corporation tax in Oregon. In the meantime they should be spared any further practice of deception. Let us have less masquerading.

METHODS THAT SHOULD BE EXPOSED.

The old Portland machine is seeking to destroy the Direct Primary law and defeat election of senators by the direct vote of the people. To do this IT MUST HAVE THE ORGANIZATION OF THE LEGISLATURE.
To secure the organization of the legislature it is asking that all members elected as Republicans GO INTO A SECRET CAUCUS, and thus give a chance for corrupt influences to prevail in the organization of both houses of the legislature.
Everybody should know that the old corrupt Portland political machine WANTS POWER SOLELY FOR PLUNDER wants the legislature organized for purposes of graft, and to defeat reforms and undo all that has been accomplished for purer politics in Oregon.
The anti-machine elements in Oregon have a majority in both houses of the legislature and SHOULD NOT BETRAY THE PEOPLE by handing over the organization to the machine.
Yet the agents of the machine have time and money to travel all over the state and solicit members of the legislature to carry out the machine program.

THE BOULEVARD TO THE FAIR GROUNDS.

If Salem is going to do anything about that boulevard from the city to the State Fair grounds it is high time some one got busy.
There has been talk for several years about the need of that street being built and yet the talk was meaningless so far as action went.

THE TIME HAS COME FOR ACTION.

The growth of the city and the growth of the State Fair alike make it necessary.
The only road to the fair grounds is occupied with a street car line and in some places is less than twenty feet wide.
Handling ten to twenty thousand people a day over such a street is dangerous to human life.
The State Fair is an institution that is entitled to CONSIDERATION AT THE HANDS OF THE COMMUNITY.
When the State Fair board holds its annual meeting here early in December a plan for the construction of that boulevard should be ready to submit.
This city should not look to the county or to the state to construct that boulevard or it will never be done.
That street is entirely within the city and no improvement WILL BENEFIT THIS CITY AS MUCH AS THAT WILL.
The committee on streets, the street commissioner, the city council, the Board of Trade, the Business Men's League, every one should get busy.
We owe it to ourselves and to the enterprising State Fair board to build that street and build it RIGHT AWAY AND WITHOUT MUCH CEREMONY.
If we are to keep pace as a city with the growth of the state and the growth of the State Fair, that street should be built regardless of expense.
There is enough brains, energy and booster spirit in the Capital City to push that much-needed IMPROVEMENT THROUGH WITHOUT DELAY.
This city will make a great and serious mistake if it does not meet the State Fair management more than half way in its labors to make the Oregon State Fair a source of state pride.
LET US ALL BOOST FOR THE BOULEVARD.

ORRANIZE TO FIGHT HIGH FREIGHT RATES

(United Press Leased Wire.)
San Francisco, Nov. 23.—Preparations were completed at several meetings and conferences this week, having for their object the organization of a strong opposition against the new freight rates, which have been threatened by the trans-continental railroads and which, it is claimed, would work grave injury to the interests of the Pacific coast tanners, fruit canners, fruit driers, bean growers, ship chandlers and shoe finders.
The object of the meetings of this week will be to enlist the assistance of the merchants' exchange and the chamber of commerce in presenting the claims of the growers, manufacturers and shippers to the interstate commerce commission. A special meeting of the traffic bureau of the Merchants' Exchange will be held tomorrow when data, supporting the contention of the business men will be presented. A special meeting of the chamber of commerce will probably be called later in the week, and a convention of business men will be assembled at an early date under the auspices of the California Traffic association, all having, as their object, the same protest against the new tariff.
