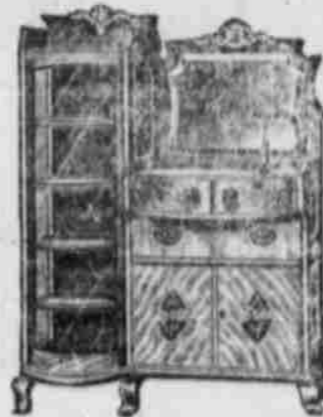

torney whether or not he wished his case tried out in the justice court, but after several attempts to induce him to give his wishes, he was given the necessary examination and was bound over to the grand jury to await action. In answering questions regarding his desires as to his handling by the courts, he apparently gave little consideration of what his future circumstances would be and although making no definite statement, he is strongly in favor of being deported back to Japan.

The district attorney made a careful examination into Yashita's case, and the following law taken from the statutes of Oregon is sufficient to mete out the necessary punishment:

Section 1950, entitled "Indecent and immoral acts not otherwise made punishable—If any person shall wilfully and wrongfully commit an act which grossly endangers the presence or the property of others, or by grossly disturbing the public

peace or lives, or by openly outraging the public decency and is injurious to public morals, such person, if no punishment is expressly prescribed therefor by this code, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail not less than one month nor more than six months. Or by a fine not less than \$50 nor more than \$200."

Yashita's Japanese friends in this city called at the sheriff's office this morning and stated their desire to raise funds among them to deport the prisoner back to Japan, but it is hardly probable they will go to that trouble after hearing of the action taken against him. The local Japanese have been corresponding with officials from their home country in relation to Yashita's predicament, but owing to the fact that he has been in this country over three years, the Japanese government has lost control to order him back under their ruling.

No other complications have come to light as far as can be learned regarding the actions of Yashita during the small space of time he has been a free man.
