## OREGON GLEE CLUB TO ENTERTAIN AT THE GRAND TONIGHT

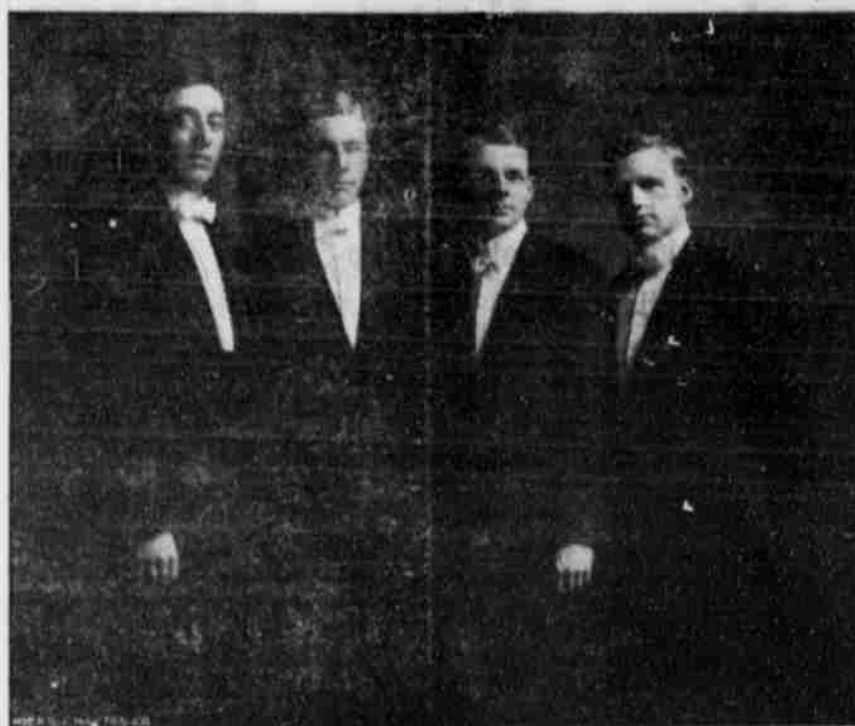
With the coming of the University of Oregon Glee and Madolin clubs, who appear at the Grand opera house tonight, local people will once again have an opportunity of witnessing an entertainment out of the ordinary, something full of spirit and vigor. There is no class of people on earth that carries a more distinctive air, that has a more typical bearing than the college student, and there is a particular charm about his actions, whether on or off the stage, which makes him more than ordinarily interesting to watch.

The Oregon clubs are composed of typical students from a typical college, and people who want a glimpse of real college life will not be disappointed in the men who represent the state university. On the other hand, those who love music for its own sake will find the concert all that can be desired. Prof. Glenn is recognized as a musical director throughout the country, and he has

had more talent and trained voices with which to work this year than in any previous season of the clubs. Critics who have seen the first concert of the clubs this year do not hesitate to proclaim them the best that ever represented the university of Oregon. The stunts this year, too, are more than usually creditable. Mr. Voight's dialect monologues, one humorous and the other pathetic, are of such a quality that they would do credit to any professional impersonator. Van Dusen furnishes the most laughable element. He is a genuine comedian and never fails to strike a responsive chord of merriment.

Besides these leading stunts, Ogden and Geisler have a piano stunt, which is a "take-off" on the piano fields, the convict quartette appears in a song and dance, and there are several comic songs by the whole club.

The mandolin selections, three in number, round out a well-balanced and thoroughly enjoyable program.

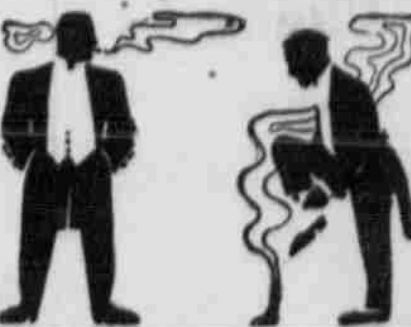
