GETS EVIDENCE AGAINST BLACK

John H. McNary has completed his examination of witnesses in the case of Black, the man who is alleged to have shot Dr. Charles Roberson, and the chain of evidence which the district attorney has secured is almost complete, according to statements made by him today.

Testimony was taken from every person in any way knowingly connected with the affair. The district attorney's examination started from witnesses making the discovery of the injured man, leading along until the final capture of Black in North Salem. The evidence secured yesterday afternoon goes to confirm the allegations in relation to Black's revolver, mask and the

many cartridges which he had on his person at the time of his capture by Johnson and Tweedy. A new witness was brought to testify of having seen Black passing up and down the railroad track on Trade street. This witness, whose identity is withheld for many reasons, stated that he saw Black go to and fro from the city by the Southern Pacific switch track a good many times. Every day, for eight days, he said Black, or a person answering to his description, passed along the railroad track, coming from some place east and apparently going to the city. Another witness, who has also desired his name withheld, observed Black camping several times near the Vogel Lumber Co's warehouses, in the vicinity of the S. P. passenger depot.

The testimony taken from witnesses yesterday will be put in force at the coming trial of the alleged robber in connection with numerous other losses picked up by the district attorney.

\$10,000 FOR REAL AMERICAN OPERA

(United Press Leased Wire.) New York, Dec. 16.—A \$10,000 prize competition for an American opera, written by an American composer, is the novelty announced today by the Metropolitan Opera company. The contest opens next Sunday, December 20, and closes on September 15 of next year. The award of the big prize will be made by a jury of recognized authorities, and the successful opera will be staged at the Metropolitan, the exclusive rights of the production belonging to the opera company for five years.

The principal conditions of the contest are that the opera shall not exceed a time-limit of three and one-quarter hours and the libretto must be in English. Adaptations from existing literary works will be allowed, but they must be new adaptations.

JUDGE TELLS GRAND JURY TO INDICT HIM

(United Press Leased Wire.) Yreka, Cal., Dec. 16.—Members of the grand jury received a notification from Superior Judge J. S. Beard today that they must either indict him for illegally drawing money from the county auditor or indict his accuser, the publisher of the Biskayon News.

The judge called attention to certain articles in the newspaper in which it was alleged that the judge was committing felonies by illegally drawing orders upon the auditor for money to be paid out of the county funds to the court reporter.

The jury was instructed to ascertain if the charges were true and if substantiated, to indict the judge. If they were shown false, the jurors were instructed to indict his accusers. The judge cites authorities to support his practice.
