WILSON CHARGED WITH POISONING

Coroner's Jury Decides He Sent Powders Which Killed Harry Boas.

(United Press Leased Wire.) San Francisco, Dec. 17.—John Walter Wilson, who was charged yesterday by a coroner's jury with the murder of Harry Boas, the young electrician, who died two weeks ago, after swallowing "stomach powders," which had been sent him through the mails in a mysterious letter, purporting to come from a friendly "doctor." The testimony in yesterday's inquest which decided the jury's verdict was that furnished by Handwriting Expert Theodore Kytka who positively asserted that the "doctor's" letter had been written by none other than Wilson himself.

Wilson received the verdict stoically and coolly pointed out the flaws in the evidence which had been massed against him. He said that the district attorney's office had been unable to establish a motive for the crime, and had been unable to prove that he bought the strychnine, as, heretofore, the detectives have been boastful in the search for the drug store where the poison was purchased.

Despite these weak points in the case as presented to the coroner's jury, the police believe that they can so strengthen the evidence before Wilson goes to trial that it will be an easy matter to convict him. A formal charge was sworn to last evening, and the prisoner was returned to his cell in the city prison just when he expected to be released on a writ of habeas corpus.

The crime for which Wilson has been accused by the coroner's jury, is that of causing the death of Boas, his employer, and proprietor of the Pennant Electrical Company, on Wednesday night, December 3, sending him, under the guise of medicine, two deadly powders containing strychnine. Boas, supposing that the powders came from some "doctor" who had corresponded with him at the instigation of a sweetheart of his at San Jose, went home with the "medicine," and, all unsuspecting, drank it just before retiring. Half an hour afterwards his family was aroused by his groans and struggles, and in a very short while the young man dead.

Examination of the letter which accompanied the poison has made Handwriting Expert Kytka absolutely positive that Wilson wrote it. Corroboration of his opinion is found in a comparison between the letter paper and the paper in which the powders were wrapped with paper found in Wilson's room at the Hotel Netherlands, or known to have been in Wilson's possession.

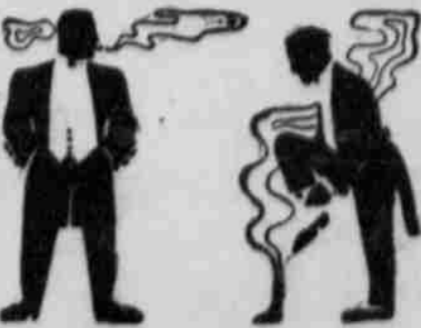
