

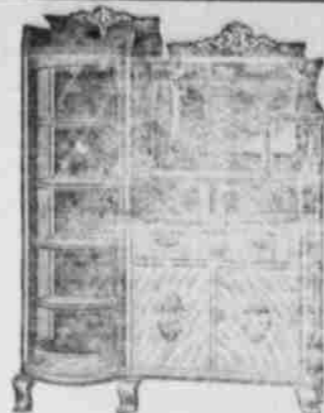

A buffet and China Closet in one piece is a wonderful convenience and economizes room.



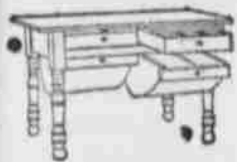

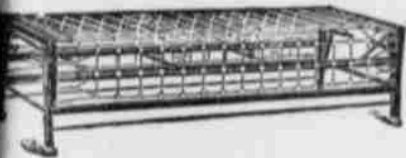
