The manager of the Folies Pigalle, who, with two actresses was acquitted by the lower court because his exhibition was adjudged "artistic," received an unpleasant surprise when the appellate court put his show in the same "obscene" category as that of the Little Palace.

He was sentenced to three months imprisonment and his models were given 15 days.
