USE ACID INSTEAD OF BLASTING POWDER

F. S. Schauble, who has a ranch on route No. 8, Labish bottom, with very heavy timber on it, is trying an experiment in the way of destroying big stumps with acid. He bored into a big stump and poured in a quart of sulphuric and nitric acid, equal parts, and put in a plug. It boiled and smoked as if the whole stump were being eaten up, and he believes that in 30 days there will be little left of that stump, as the acid is expected to follow the grain of the wood to the roots and destroy it all as far as it goes. The cost for a large stump is 30 cents at retail, but, if he can get it in large quantities, he will reduce the cost to 20 cents per stump, while powder costs one dollar. He says he will report to The Journal what success he has.

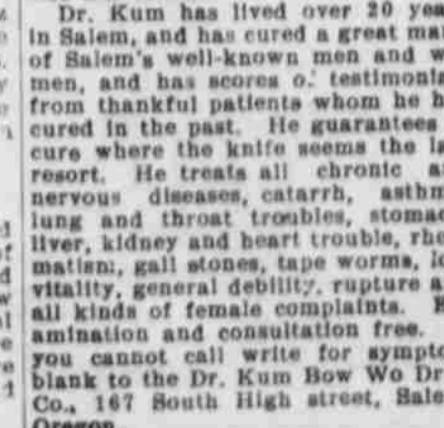
