## FOOD WAS FULL OF DISEASE GERMS

(Untied Press Leased Wire.)  
Vallejo, Cal., Dec. 22.—George Wildason, a marine hospital steward at Mare Island navy yard, announced today that he had completed a bacteriological examination of the beef served at the memorable launching of the collar Prometheus, and, as a result of that work, he found the food full of those germs which are common to decomposed meat.  
Wildason's testimony will probably be used in the coroner's inquest into the death of James Reynolds, a waiter at the luncheon, who ate some of the poisoned food, and died a few days later in San Francisco. The inquest will be held in San Francisco tomorrow morning, and a large number of government officials, city officials of Vallejo and guests at the luncheon will appear as witnesses. Leon Cohn, the caterer for the ill-fated luncheon, will also give his testimony.
