Wm. Conley, of the firm of D. Conley & Sons, one of the largest firms of fruit exporters of New York City, has been in Salem the past few days seeing different fruit men in regard to handling their products.

This year his firm handled the "Comtee" pears of the Wallace orchard, selling them at wholesale in New York City at an average of \$2.60 per half box. Mr. Conley will be on the coast for at least three months, during the apple and pear season...

TALK BASEBALL FOR NEXT SEASON

Baseball talk is again circulating about this city, and many of the fans are curious to know just what the situation will be in Salem for next year in the ball line.

Notwithstanding the rumpus being kicked up in San Francisco by the Pacific Coast league officials and the different state league men, the Valley league in Oregon, which was proposed and put under way some time ago by Salem, Eugene, Albany, Roseburg and Woodburn baseball magnates, is progressing nicely, and unless some unforeseen difficulty arises, the Willamette valley will undoubtedly get its name in the baseball world in good shape.

The new Valley league to be has secured protection and rights from the National committee and will be in the ball market with the best amateur players obtainable by the time the season has fairly opened up. Arrangements have been made by the different town managers in the league for grounds, and Salem will probably put Asylum avenue park into use again, as this location is the most favorable of any in any distance of the city and will require but little labor to put it in first class order.

Many are under the impression that the Capital City is not capable of supporting a first class baseball aggregation. This has actually, but not justly been the case heretofore, being partly due to the teams is admitted, but the greater part due to the non-support of the fans. Salem business men have responded loyally in touching the enthusiasm off when a team was to be organized and their contributions were large and many, but business men alone cannot and will not hold a base ball team on its feet the year round with no compensation outside of having the opportunity of seeing them play once or twice a week.

It takes the support of the fans and the public in general to do the holding-up part; and men who will attend the games and men who will give all the encouragement possible to the home team from first to last instead of becoming disinterested and unconcerned about baseball when their team loses four or five games straight. It takes the encouragement to make a ball player get up on his toes and down to his best, and not a continuous string of reproaches and joshes should he be unucky and pass up a few easy grounders or drop a pop fly which is a thing possible for the best player on earth.

This was considerably the case with the "Cherry Pickers" in Salem last season. This team had ability and willingness and played games in a manner creditable at which times they received the big hand from all Salem, but on a few occasions they dropped under the snow and played extremely bad ball and at that they received the roasts of their lives on every occasion until along the latter part of the season, the fans began to drop out of sight one by one until a small handful attended the games, resulting in the practical disbandment of the "Cherry Pickers."

To be sure, it takes money to make a ball team, but an entire fortune could not make the game interesting where no enthusiasm and good feeling is in evidence.
